1 Introduction and Background

Purpose of Report

- 1.1 To provide Members with:
- a) The progress made by the Shared Internal Audit Service (SIAS) in delivering the Council's 2014/15 Internal Audit Plan as at 30 May 2014.
 - b) The findings for the period 7 March 2014 to 30 May 2014.
 - c) The proposed amendments required to the approved Annual Internal Audit Plan.
 - d) The implementation status of previously agreed Audit Recommendations.
 - e) An update on performance management information as at 30 May 2014.

Background

- 1.2 Internal Audit's Annual Plan for 2014/15 was approved by the Audit Committee at its meeting on 24 March 2014.
- 1.3 The Audit Committee receive periodic updates against the Annual Internal Audit Plan. This is the first report giving feedback on the delivery of the 2014/15 Internal Audit Plan.
- 1.4 The work of Internal Audit is required to be reported to a Member Body so that the Council has an opportunity to review and monitor an essential component of corporate governance and gain assurance that its internal audit function is fulfilling its statutory obligations. It is considered good practice that progress reports also include proposed amendments to the agreed Annual Internal Audit Plan.

2 Audit Plan Update

Delivery of Audit Plan and Key Audit Findings

- 2.1 As at 30 May 2014, 17% of the 2014/15 Audit Plan days had been delivered (calculation excludes contingency days that have not been allocated). We forecast that at least 95% of the Audit Plan days will be completed by 31 March 2015. Appendix A provides a status update on each individual deliverable within the audit plan.

Proposed Audit Plan Amendments

- 2.3 Consultation with management has resulted in the cancellation of planned reviews of the IT Help Desk and the Supporting People Grant. A review of Rechargeable Major Works has been scheduled to replace the former and the balance of time has been returned to contingency.

Reporting of Audit Plan Delivery Progress

- 2.4 At the meeting of this Committee on 18 November 2013 it was agreed that the method for reporting on audit plan delivery progress be based on the judgement of the SIAS management team and representing the best estimate as to a reasonable expectation of progress on the audit plan. This approach is reflected in the figures at 2.9 (below).
- 2.5 To help the Committee in assessing the current situation in terms of progress against the projects in the audit plan we have continued to provide an overall progress update in the table below. In addition, for 14/15 we have agreed formal audit start dates with management and have allocated resources accordingly; details can be found in Appendix C. This is designed to help facilitate a smoother level of audit plan delivery through the year.
