1. PURPOSE

In acknowledgement and subject to consideration by the Community Select Committee and approval by Executive, this Council agrees to make a public commitment to carers, along the lines of the attached draft (at appendix A), which states what we can offer to Carers, both through our services and as an employer. This will enable Carers to know what we will do to support their invaluable contribution to the town.

Through this commitment, the Council pledges to ensure Carers are recognised as important people in our local community.
