1. PURPOSE

To advise Council of the results of the Borough Council Elections in Bandley Hill, Bedwell, Chells, Longmeadow, Manor, Martins Wood, Old Town, Pin Green, Roebuck, St. Nicholas, Shephall, Symonds Green and Woodfield Wards held on 22 May 2014 together with the percentage turnouts.

3. DETAILS

At the local Elections on 22 May 2014 all wards in Stevenage had contested elections. Over 22,000 postal votes were sent out, with 32 Polling Stations opened.
