1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE AND DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

An apology for absence was received from Councillor R Briscoe.

Councillors A McGuinness, R Parker CC and G Snell declared a Non Pecuniary Interest with regards to Item 12 – Standards Committee Determination.

2. MINUTES – 26 FEBRUARY 2014

It was **RESOLVED** that subject to the following amendments noted below, the Minutes of the Council meeting of 26 February 2014 be approved as a correct record and signed by the Deputy Mayor.

Third paragraph of item 8 of the above Minutes on page 8 – should read Parker Morris Standards and not 'Peter Morris'.

Also with regards to Item 5 of the Minutes on page 2, the paragraph starting 'Leader of the Minority Group', the second sentence be amended to read - 'He raised a number of points that were critical of the proposed budget, the consultation process and some items of expenditure and he also mentioned some positives from recent government actions, but concluded that he would support the proposals and thanked officers for their work in its preparation.'
