## **BOROUGH COUNCIL ELECTIONS 2016**

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### **1. PURPOSE**

To advise Council of the results of the Borough Council Elections in Bandle Hill, Bedwell, Chells, Longmeadow, Manor, Martins Wood, Old Town, Pin Green, Roebuck, St. Nicholas, Shephall, Symonds Green and Woodfield Wards held on 5 May 2016 together with the percentage turnouts.

### **3. DETAILS**

At the local Elections on 5 May 2016 all wards in Stevenage had contested elections. Nearly 22,000 postal votes were sent out, with 32 Polling Stations opened.
