1. PURPOSE

To advise Council of the results of the Borough Council Elections in Bandley Hill, Bedwell, Chells, Longmeadow, Manor, Martins Wood, Old Town, Pin Green, Roebuck, St. Nicholas, Shephall, Symonds Green and Woodfield Wards held on 6 May 2021 together with the percentage turnouts.

3. DETAILS

At the local Elections on 6 May 2021 all wards in Stevenage had contested elections. 21,310 postal votes were sent out, with 39 Polling Stations opened.
