## **DATA QUALITY AUDIT REPORT**

(Corporate Policy Unit)

### **NON-KEY DECISION**

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#### 1 PURPOSE

To advise members of the Audit Commission feedback on the Data Quality Review (Appendix A).

## 2 RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Audit Commission feedback on the Data Quality Review be noted.

### 3 BACKGROUND

- 3.1. The Audit Commission developed a new approach to the audit of performance indicators for 2005/06. The new approach comprised of three stages:
  - 1) Review of overall management arrangements to secure data quality
  - 2) 'Completeness check' of reported performance information
  - 3) Data quality spot checks
- 3.2. Data quality management arrangements were assessed against key lines of enquiry over five themes.
- 3.3. The 'Completeness check' was an arithmetic check of calculations for CPA indicators.
- 3.4. Data quality spot checks were completed against Planning, Decent homes and Temporary Accommodation (B & B).
- 3.5. The outcome of the audit contributes to the auditors' conclusion on arrangements to secure value for money and informs the Use of Resources assessment.

# 4 REASONS FOR RECOMMENDED COURSE OF ACTION AND OTHER OPTIONS

- 4.1 The Audit Commission report concludes that the Council has robust arrangements in place to secure the quality of data.
- 4.2 The Audit commission identified several items of 'notable practice' when reviewing management arrangements. In particular, the improved performance management and monitoring arrangements over key performance indicators.
- 4.3 The Audit Commission concluded that the indicators checked at stage 2 were arithmetically correct.
- 4.4 Data quality spot checks concluded that all the performance indicators were fairly stated.
- 4.5 As a result of the audit, the Audit Commission identified the Council's strengths, and areas for improvement.
- 4.6 An action plan addressing the recommendations in the feedback report has been prepared (Appendix B).
