# DATES OF COUNCIL MEETINGS

(Chief Executive's)

#### NON-KEY DECISION

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#### 1 PURPOSE

To recommend dates for meetings of the Council for the 2003/2004 Municipal Year.

### 2 BACKGROUND

To comply with Standing Orders the Council should approve its programme of meetings annually. The approval of dates of Council meetings for the year does not preclude extraordinary meetings being called by the Chief Executive, in consultation with the Mayor; nor for the date, time or place to be altered where a material change of circumstances makes it necessary.

# 3 REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION AND OTHER OPTIONS

3.1 The dates proposed for ordinary meetings of the Council are as follows:

11<sup>th</sup> June 2003

17<sup>th</sup> September 2003

26<sup>th</sup> November 2003

25<sup>th</sup> February 2004

3.2 Additionally, extraordinary meetings are proposed as follows:

28<sup>th</sup> January 2004 (Council Tax Base and HRA)

3.3 The date for the 2004 Annual Council is not quoted at this time as the date of the local elections next year is likely to be postponed from 6th May to 10<sup>th</sup> June. Given this delay of the elections there may also be an additional ordinary Council meeting in April. A further report on this matter will be submitted subject to the necessary primary legislation for changing the date of the elections.
