1. PURPOSE

To advise Council of the results of the Borough Council Elections in Bandle Hill, Bedwell, Chells, Longmeadow, Manor, Martins Wood, Old Town, Pin Green, Roebuck, Shephall, St. Nicholas, Symonds Green and Woodfield held on 6 May 2010 together with the percentage turnouts.

3. BACKGROUND

At the local Elections on 6 May 2010 all wards in Stevenage had contested elections. Over 22,000 postal votes were sent out, with 33 Polling Stations opened.
