Housing Development

- We are on track to build 300 new homes by 2020/21, meaning more housing and better housing for Stevenage
- We will start work at the Twin Foxes site and the March Hare site, and finish Vincent Court, building 33 homes in total
- We will complete our flagship scheme at Archer Road in 2017, delivering a new pharmacy, a convenience store and 22 new homes

Town Centre Regeneration

- We are making improvements to the town centre, making it more appealing for residents and visitors alike
