We are writing to you with reference to the above proposal to license J's Bar & Lounge Bar at Unit 6, The Plaza, Stevenage.

We, the residents of Pinetree Court 1 & 2, are very concerned at the prospect of a new bar opening up which supposedly will hold up to 400 people with a drinks license that will extend to 3am in the morning.

As things stand now we already have to put up with drunk and disorderly behaviour, i.e. shouting, urinating and fighting against the surrounding railings to our property, cans and bottles being thrown into our garden and drunken louts making a general public nuisance of themselves.

The opening of yet another club will only exacerbate the already unsatisfactory situation which is of the utmost concern to the residents and therefore hope that you will have some sympathy with our situation before coming to any decision.

We would also like to point out that many of the residents here are 80 years plus and consider a decent nights sleep is a basic human right.
