1. PURPOSE

1.1. That Members consider the licensing activity undertaken for the period 1 April – 30 June 2013

3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1. This report presents information for the period April June 2013 on licensing applications administered by officers for matters concerning:
- 3.1.1 Alcohol, entertainment, late night refreshment and personal licence permissions under the Licensing Act 2003;
- 3.1.2 Machine permits for gaming under the Gambling Act 2005;
- 3.1.3 Driver permission, vehicle licences and operators licences under the Local Government(Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 and Town Police Clauses Act 1847:
- 3.1.4 Street Trading Consents under the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982; and
- 3.1.5 Sex Establishment licensing under the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982.
- 3.1.6 Skin piercing, acupuncture, beauty treatments or tattooing under the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982
- 3.1.7 Home boarding of animals under the Animal Boarding Establishments Act 1963.

4. REASONS FOR RECOMMENDED COURSE OF ACTION AND OTHER OPTIONS

- 4.1. Appendix 1 of this report sets out the transaction and performance information for the period April June 2013. This contains the number of applications or notices as received during this period.
- 4.2. For Hackney Carriage and Private Hire licensing this data also includes information as to licences that have been suspended or revoked.
- 4.3. In addition to these applications, licensing officers have undertaken 56 inspections, and are noted as follows:
- 4.3.1. 29 Licensing Act 2003 risk assessment visits
- 4.3.2. 16 Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Vehicle Walk-Around Inspections
- 4.3.3. 6 Gambling Act 2005 premises visits in conjunction with an Enforcement Officer from the Gambling Commission
