

Contract review

SLL set up by SBC in 1989 25 years ending in 2024

Poor contract put in place 2009

2022 Leisure Review commenced

- Leisure Programme Board
- Public Consultation
- Sports Club Summit
- Options appraisal
- Contract and specification development
- 50% finance, 40% quality, 10% social value
- Procurement 9 companies two stage process
- SLL could have been removed at 1st stage
- 4 companies at final stage
- Evaluation team of 13 Contract award to Everyone Active
- SLL were bottom of the 4 bidders 176 pages of feedback given









Key contract changes

- Transfer of services, staff and customers some initial problems with DD
- Ridlins, pitch, pavilion bookings & Active Communities new to contract
- Sailing Centre SBC management
- Payment to operator year 1- 51% less than SLL, year 2 83% less
- Activity Centre Cost to SBC £114k
- New signage and branding
- Training and development programmes for staff
- Decarbonisation & sustainability
- Shared utility risk negotiated annually
- £1 million investment delivered June to Sept 23
 - Theatre Foyer
 - Fitness
 - Golf Trackman & Clubhouse refurbishment
 - Swim Centre –changing room & toilet refurbishment
 - Signage
 - New I.T and booking systems
